Guest Pass Packages

Full Conference Experience – \$265

All Conference Guest Pass – \$195

Ages 12+ – Access to the conference floor, SkillsUSA TECHSPO, SkillsUSA University, admission to Opening Session, Recognition Session, Champions Festival, and the Awards Session. Meals and state events are not included.

Illinois State Association Add-On – \$70

Access the SkillsUSA Illinois Champions Celebration Friday (dinner) after the Awards sessions. Also includes state delegation materials including state t-shirt, state pin, spirit items and more.

Children’s Conference Guest Pass (under age 12) – Free

Children under 12 must register to receive a badge credential and will receive access to the conference floor, SkillsUSA TECHSPO and Champions Festival. Session tickets for children not included with free registration. Meals and state events are not included.

Children’s General Session Package (ages 3-11) – \$75

Access to the live sessions in State Farm Arena; Opening Session, Recognition Session, and the Awards Session. Meals and state events are not included.

**Children under three are free and may sit on an adult’s lap.*

Children under three will not have a seat reserved. Purchase a children’s package to reserve a seat.
