Competition Description

Encourage career technical students to develop a learning-based project that will benefit their school, industry, or community with a focus on their career preparation program. They will then develop a display to use in their community to explain the project, their studies, and its benefits.

Tasks To Be Evaluated

The teams will use their course of study as the basis of a project that will benefit their class, school, community or industry. The project must highlight an aspect of their career cluster training. Upon completion of the project, the team will develop a display and use it within their community to explain their training and their project. This competition will judge mastery of their training, its application, the project’s benefit to their community, and display and presentation techniques.

Clothing Requirement

National Requirement:

Class A: SkillsUSA Official Attire

- Official SkillsUSA red blazer or official SkillsUSA red jacket
Button-up, collared, white dress shirt (accompanied by a plain, solid black tie or SkillsUSA black tie), white shirt (collarless or small-collared) or white turtleneck, with any collar not to extend into the lapel area of the blazer, sweater, windbreaker or jacket
Black dress slacks or black dress skirt (knee-length at minimum)
Black dress shoes

National Requirement OR Business Professional Attire.
