Competition Description

Evaluate each competitor's ability to demonstrate and explain an entry-level skill used in the occupational area for which he or she is training.

Tasks To Be Evaluated

The demonstration is a presentation of an occupational skill accompanied by a clear explanation of the topic through the use of examples, experiences, displays or practical operations.

Clothing Requirement

National Requirement:

SkillsUSA Official Attire or official white polo shirt with black dress slacks, black socks and black leather shoes.

State Requirement:

Class A: Official Attire - SkillsUSA Official Attire or Business Professional Attire

Additional Information

Competitors must wear their official competition clothing to the competition orientation meeting.

*An assistant may be used to set up and dismantle the demonstration, or may be used as a prop or model, but in no way can assist with the presentation. An advisor may not serve as an assistant. The presentation assistant model/helper must be a SkillsUSA student member, and in official dress.

Provided by Competitor

- All materials and equipment needed for the demonstration to be completed two times, once for the preliminaries and again for the finals, if required.
- The competitor will present a 3"x5" card to the chair upon entering the competition room. This card will contain the following three items:
 - The competitor's number
 - The topic or purpose of the demonstration
 - The competitor's training program
- All competitors must create a one-page resume and submit a hard copy to the technical committee chair at orientation.
