Competition Description

To encourage local SkillsUSA chapters to promote the organization, career and technical education, and related occupational information through a promotional bulletin board.

Tasks To Be Evaluated

The competition requires the development of a promotional bulletin board using the SkillsUSA national theme, and it may also include promotion of local SkillsUSA chapter activities or technical, skilled and service occupations, including health occupations. Skill also will be evaluated through an interview.

Clothing Requirement

National Requirement:

Official white polo shirt with black dress slacks, black socks and black leather shoes.

State Requirement:

Class A: Official Attire - SkillsUSA Official Attire or Business Professional Attire

Additional Information

The competitor must wear their official competition clothing to the competition orientation meeting.
