Competition Description

This competition evaluates students' preparation for firefighting careers through hands-on skill demonstrations and both written and oral presentations. Areas tested include: safety; breathing apparatus; fire streams; ladders, ropes, knots and hoses; fire control; ventilation; emergency medical care and rescue; and protecting fire cause evidence.

Tasks To Be Evaluated

Competitors competing in the firefighter competition required to follow NFPA 1001 standards for basic firefighter operations.

- Donning and doffing drills with SCBA
- Job interview focus with firefighter knowledge
- Ropes and knots with hoisting
- Tool identification
- Modified Candidate physical ability test
- Stair climb with two and a half high-rise pack, forcible entry using a Kaiser sled, hose pull, ceiling prop, tool Carry, mannequin drag.

- Everything needed for the testing of firefighting skills including full SCBA.

Clothing Requirement

National Requirement:

Class D: Competition Specific: Blue Attire

- Official SkillsUSA light blue work shirt
- Navy pants
- Black, brown, or tan leather work safety shoes (with protective toe cap).

State Requirement:

National Requirement OR similar "like" clothing.

- Light blue work shirt
- Work pants of any kind are acceptable dress (no jeans)
- Black, brown, or tan leather work safety shoes (with protective toe cap).
- Any embroidered names or school patches must be covered if applicable.
