Competition Description

Evaluate local chapter activities that benefit the community and to recognize excellence and professionalism in the area of community service. This event also enables the community to become aware of the outstanding work being performed by career and technical education students.

Tasks To Be Evaluated

The competition will consist of two parts: a notebook outlining the chapter community service project and a live presentation by the chapter team. The chapter will organize the year’s community service activities and present its best community service project to a panel of judges. Only one project may be presented. Notebooks containing information about more than one project will not be judged.

The notebook and presentation should represent a community service project that was conceived, planned and completed during the current school year.

Clothing Requirement

National Requirement:

Class A: SkillsUSA Official Attire

- Official SkillsUSA red blazer or official SkillsUSA red jacket
- Button-up, collared, white dress shirt (accompanied by a plain, solid black tie or SkillsUSA black tie), white shirt (collarless or small-collared) or white turtleneck, with any collar not to extend into the lapel area of the blazer, sweater, windbreaker or jacket

State Requirement:

SkillsUSA Official Attire or Business Professional Attire.

Provided by Competitor

- SkillsUSA three-ring binder documenting the project. ***Note** binders can be picked up from HQ on Saturday
- Laptop computer, LCD projector (optional or other visual equipment as necessary for the presentation. Backup must be ready and available if technical problems occur.
- Clicker (for your specific equipment).
- Notecards, if desired.
- All competitors must create a one-page resume and submit a hard copy to the technical committee chair at orientation.

Provided by Technical Committee

- LCD projector and screen
- Access to power
- Timer

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- Black dress slacks or black dress skirt (knee-length at minimum)
- Black dress shoes
