Competition Description

Evaluate a competitor's knowledge of early childhood education based on developmentally appropriate practice for children ages 3–5 years. This is demonstrated through a written test, interview, literary reading and the ability to create and implement a lesson in a designated content area as determined by the committee.

Tasks To Be Evaluated

The skill performance of this contest consists of three parts: Ability to interview and answer questions pertaining to working in a childcare facility, ability to create and implement a developmentally appropriate lesson in an assigned curricular area and the ability to demonstrate a developmentally appropriate literary reading

Clothing Requirement

Presentation & Preparation Times (Illinois Specific)

Competitors will be given 1 hour to plan their lesson and prepare their materials need for their presentation. Students will interview and complete their book reading demonstration within their 1 hour of planning time. Students should expect to be in the competition area for approximately 90 minutes. Please arrive 15 minutes before your competition time.

Lesson Demonstration: Competitors will be given five minutes to present their lesson.

Book Reading Demonstration: Competitors will be given four minutes to present their book reading.

Interview: Competitors will be interviewed for four minutes for their interview (approximately 3 questions).
