Competition Description

The competition consists of workstations that require the building of a small cabinet or piece of furniture from the materials and drawings supplied. Competitors are expected to read the drawings and lay out and cut the parts using a table saw, laminate trimmer, hand drill, hinge boring machine and various hand tools. The parts must be accurately assembled, sanded and adjusted to tolerances specified by the judges.

- Apply wood veneers and plastic laminates
- Assembly, fasten and install components
- Cut and shape components
- Design and layout materials
- Finish surfaces
