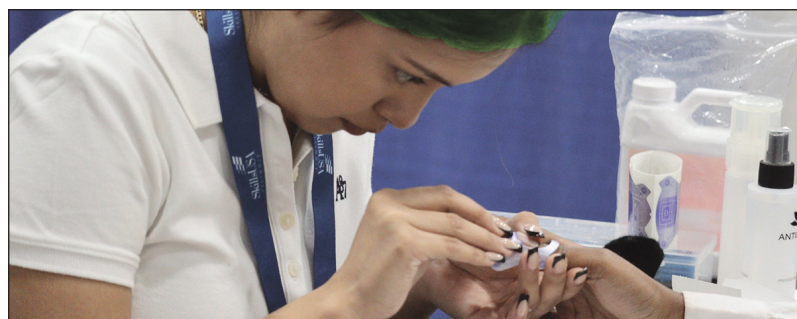
SkillsUSA Illinois TECHSPO

Career Competition Overview

The SkillsUSA Illinois Championships program assesses and recognizes career and technical education students. These career competitions engage members by testing their skills against standards for entry-level workers in the skilled trades through authentic skill demonstrations. The SkillsUSA Technical Standards are considered the “rule book” of the competitions and outlines the competencies assessed. The competitions simulate the skills needed to be an entry level professional in the field.

The SkillsUSA Championships program connects the work done by students at the local level to the national level. Members must have proven competency at the local and then regional level to advance to the State Championships. At the state competition, student members’ career readiness is evaluated by expert representatives of business, industry and organized labor. The gold medalist of each competition advances on to represent Illinois in the SkillsUSA Championships at the National Leadership & Skills Conference held each June in Atlanta, Georgia.

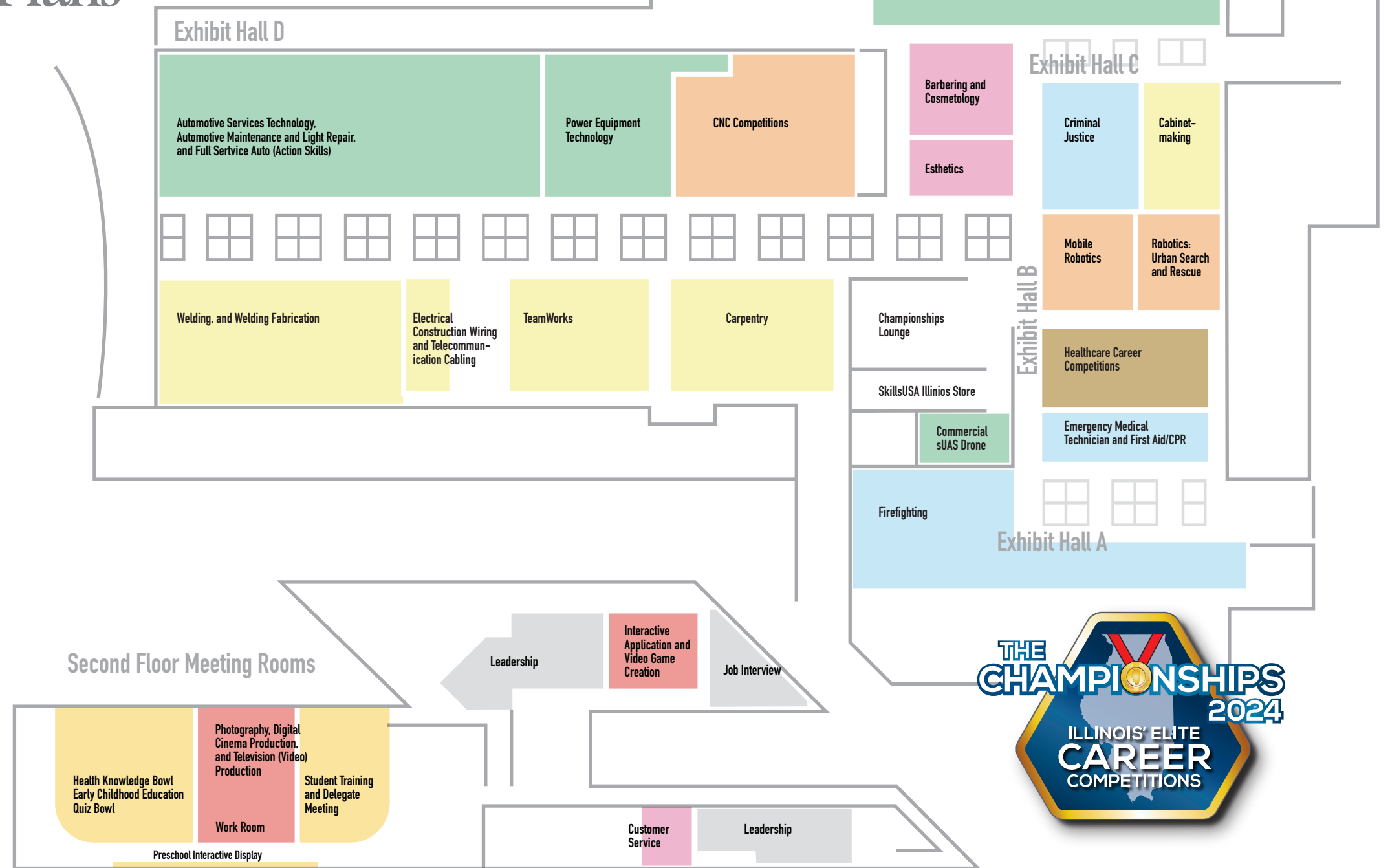
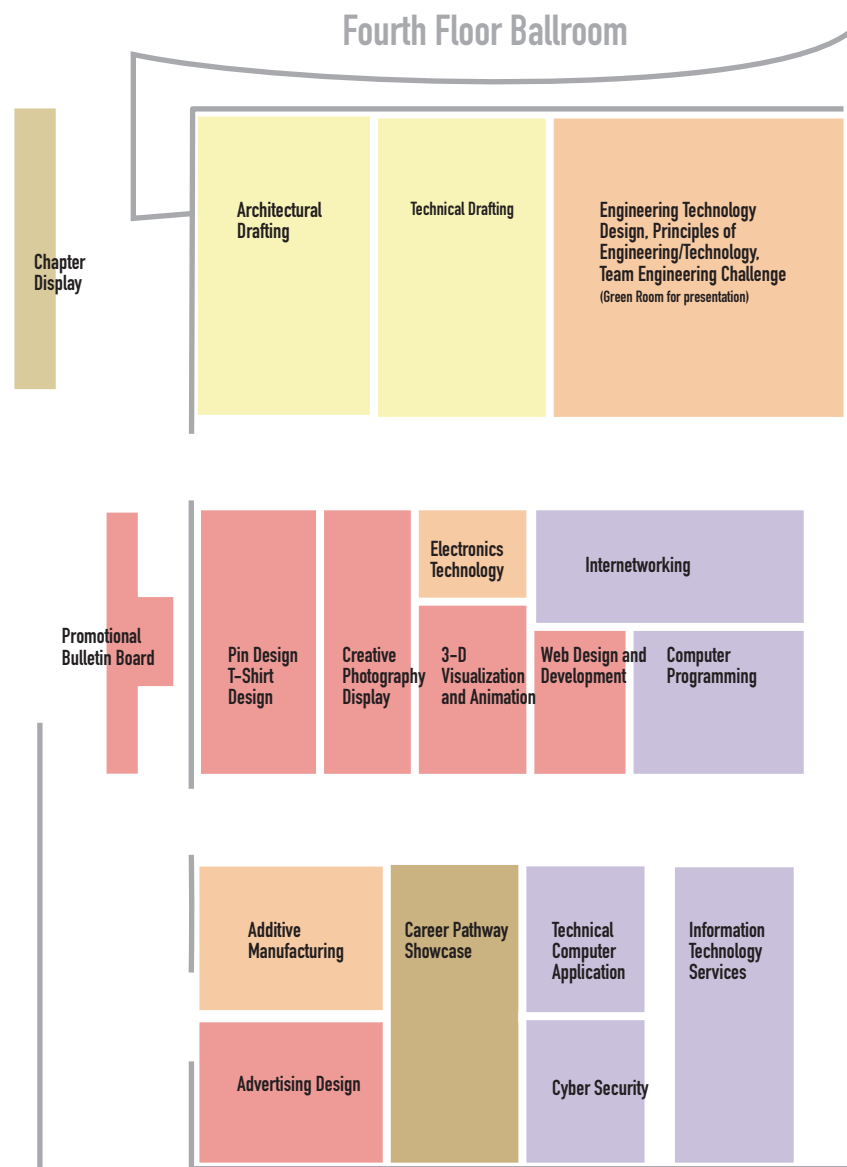
