# First Year/Reactivation Start-Up

Training programs in their first year or who are reactivating pay a one time start-up fee for administrative work to on-board the site. This includes a credit for two instructor training seats that must be completed during this year.

# NCCER Testing Subscription (High School)

All NCCER module tests must be given through the NCCER Testing System. This annual Subscription allows students to complete as many module tests as they would like during a given school year (July 1st -June 30th). This system allows instructors to manage tests administration and generate score reports. When tests are complete, scores are automatically uploaded to the NCCER registry and student transcripts.

#### SkillsUSA Membership

SkillsUSA membership is required for all students and instructors participating in NCCER programs. Annual SkillsUSA membership provides access to career resources and contacts with industry, job contacts and networking opportunities, as well as recognition opportunities.
